### 6 Sep 2022 / DAY 1

Welcome Dinner Together.


Overnight in Delhi.

### 7 Sep 2022 / DAY 2

After early breakfast, proceed for the Full Day sightseeing.

Begin with a visit to Humayun's Tomb. This bewitching architectural wonder is one of the best preserved Mughal Monument. Hamida Banu built this mausoleum in memory of her deceased husband, emperor Humayun in 1572.

Then travel to the bustling Asia's Largest Spice Market of Chandni Chowk and immerse yourself in the oldest trade in the world. We will travel the small lanes and the vibrant life that is the heart of Old Delhi. Visit Jamma Masjid - the imperial mosque of the mughal



emperors. Visit the street vendors and eat the best Jalebi in the world.

Spend the early evening time at the Lotus Temple, the emblem of the Baha'i Faith for quiet reflection under this architectural wonder.

South Indian Dinner in Connaught Place. Time for Shopping.

### **8 Sep 2022 / DAY 3**

DELHI – JAIPUR (245kms/ 5 hours drive approx)

#### JAIPUR SIGHTSEEING

Drive to Jaipur early morning. Jaipur was and still remains the only city in the world symbolizing the nine divisions of the universe, through nice rectangular sectors sub-dividing it. It is a royal city and its surroundings are rather like an endless museum. The delightfully laid out gardens and parks and attractive monuments are worthy of admiration. Say hello to the elephants and camels along the way.


On arrival, have a guided excursion to Amber Fort. Within the complex, Ganesh Pol, an imposing gateway painted with images of the elephant-headed god, Ganesh takes pride of the place. Also a part of the complex is the Diwan-I-Aam (Hall of the Public audience) with its spectacular display of pillars. The typical merging of Rajput and Mughal architectural styles is captured in the Sukh Nivas and Jas Mandir apartments, and the Charbagh garden with its perfectly proportioned landscaping. Beyond the rampants, the old city, once the abode of the aristocracy, has a wonderfully medieval flavour, though it has few buildings of majestic proportion that are still extant.

Evening with your guides to wander the architecture and local bazaars, which are known for its embroidered leather shoes, blue pottery, tie and dye scarves and other exotic wares, or relax at your hotel.

### **9 Sep 2022 / DAY 4**

#### JAIPUR



After breakfast enjoy the guided sightseeing tour of the the astronomical park built by Maharaja Jai Singh, the notable astronomer.

JAIPUR — AGRA (239 kms/ 5 hours drive approx)

After visit continue drive to Agra. Agra is famous as the home to one of the Seven Wonders of the World – the Taj Mahal. The architectural splendour of the mausoleums, the fort and the palaces in Agra is a vivid reminder of the opulence of the legendary Mughal Empire. Agra was their capital for nearly a hundred years from 1564. A pleasant town, with a comparatively easy pace, Agra is known for its superb inlay work on marble and soapstone by artisans who are hereditary craft persons. The city is also famous for its carpets, gold thread embroidery and leather shoes.

### **10 Sep 2022 / DAY 5**

AGRA – DELHI DEPARTURE (200kms/ 4 hours drive approx)

Early morning during sunrise visit to the immortal TAJ MAHAL, the inimitable poem in white marble is the first expression of love of an Emperor Shahjahan for his beloved queen Mumtaz Mahal. Its stunning architectural beauty is beyond any adequate description. The Taj rises on a high red sandstone base topped by a huge white marble terrace on which rests the famous dome flanked by four tapering minarets. Within the dome lies the jewel-inlaid cenotaph of the queen. Standing in the centre of a luxurious Persian garden, it is an architectural jewel of its time, with its unparalleled glory and exquisiteness surpassing beyond all human imaginations.
